



GROW Pathway to AHC51416 Diploma of Agribusiness Management

GROW graduates will have already completed four of the required ten units for this qualification:

STEP ONE – COMPLETED ✓	
BSBWOR501	Manage personal work priorities and professional development
AHCBUS501	Manage staff
BSBREL401	Establish networks
AHCWRK403	Supervise work routines and staff performance

STEP TWO – Complete the online course *Farm business planning*. This course takes you through the process of developing a farm business plan that is suitable to take to a third party such as your bank manager. This then leads to the setting and review of performance indicators so that you can monitor progress against your planned objectives.

STEP THREE – Complete the remaining four units via Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
